- Pick up art work: June 26 – June 29, 10 am – 4pm

Eligibility:

- Artist must be at least 16 years or older.

Entries:

- Artist's name, title of piece, media, and price must be written on a card and affixed to the back or bottom of the entry.
- All media forms are welcome.
- Artists may submit entry forms for up to three pieces.
- All work must be priced for \$100 or less. Sales price includes 35% commission to Art Speaks Gallery.
- Including a digital picture of entry is highly encouraged to help Bay School staff plan the exhibition display and publish the exhibition on the website.
- Two dimensional art must be ready to hang with wire hanging system. Please no saw tooth hangers.
- An entry should weigh no more than 30 pounds.
- The Bay School reserves the right to exclude artwork that may be inappropriate for all audiences, or does not meet our standards of professionalism.

Notification: Art Speaks Gallery will notify artists which entries will be included in the show based on the number of entries received. Space considerations as well as distribution of media will be determining factors.

Sales: All work submitted must be priced for sale including commission (35% to Art Speaks Gallery)

Reception: Artists are encouraged to attend and spread the word about the opening reception. Marketing materials are available upon request.
